- NO OPEN FLAMES. Yes, this includes sterno.
- Decorations are permitted (by all means, make the space pretty!), with the following restrictions:
 - \Rightarrow NO confetti or glitter;
 - \Rightarrow NO scotch/masking/duct tape on the walls, ceiling or posts;
 - \Rightarrow NO nails, tacks, staples, etc. on the walls, ceiling, or posts;
 - \Rightarrow NO Command strips or hooks on the walls, ceiling, or posts;
 - ⇒ Any balloons must be removed from the facility at the end of your party. Please don't leave them inflated in the trash cans or dumpsters.
- NO ALCOHOL.
- **NO SMOKING.** Smoking is prohibited on the property, this includes the parking lot.



- Be sure to turn off all lights and exit the facility by the end of your rental period. Doors will lock automatically.
